³ 1.5 years of Physical Education and .5 years of Health are required for graduation. The first two years of Athletics will include embedded Health requirements.

⁴The state of Louisiana allows students in non-public schools to substitute History of Religion (on-level Theology IV) as a fourth social studies class. While this counts as a Social Studies TOPS class for the state, colleges and universities may require a traditional 4th Social Studies like World History, AP World History, DE or AP Psychology.

* Students with a Service Plan may take Study Skills one or more years based on a student's disability, current Service Plan & administrative input. This counts toward elective credits.

** Students must graduate with 30 credits completed. Seniors who have passed all courses are eligible for up to two Off Periods. More selective colleges encourage students to limit off periods.

All students undergo individual advising on a yearly basis (Four-year planning/IGP process). At that time, TOPS and Board of Regents requirements as well as the student's interest and future plans will be addressed.

Honors Distinction Requirements (for the class of 2021 and above)

- Minimum 8 Semesters Cumulative GPA: 3.75
- 7 credits from Honors/AP/DE courses from any subject area
- 3 years of same World Language
