



2020-2021 Subsidy Parish Approval Form for SLCHS Students (9th – 12th)

Subsidy Policy of the Owner Parishes

To receive a subsidy from one of the 13 owner parishes of St. Louis Catholic High School the following criteria must be met.

Families must be parishioners in good standing with one of the 13 owner parishes. A parishioner in good standing is defined as those who (1) are officially registered with their parish for at least one year, (2) who worship regularly, and (3) who offer regular financial donations to their parish. All three criteria are used in determining eligibility of parish subsidized tuition. The weekly church offering record is an indication of the family's presence at Mass and of the monetary support. Of course, involvement in the church by way of ministry is also a valued consideration.

Parish subsidized tuition is granted on a year to year basis following an annual review of each family's financial support record and church involvement. Please keep this in mind as you prepare for the new school year.

This form must be completed and submitted to the SLCHS Finance Office by April 15, 2020.
